Medicare Recipients Brace Yourselves for Back & Knee Brace Scams



How to Respond to the Brace Scam



- 1. Report receiving any unordered Durable Medical Equipment (DME) items such as back braces, knee braces or any other type of brace as FRAUD to 1-800-MEDICARE as soon as possible.
- 2. Check your Medicare Summary Notice (MSN) to see the name of the ordering provider and be sure to tell 1-800-MEDICARE if you have never seen this person.
- 3. Contact the supplier about return. Return should be no cost to you, the beneficiary.
- 4. If you return an item, be sure to get a receipt for the items being returned.
- 5. Three to four weeks after you report the fraud to 1-800-MEDICARE, you should receive an adjusted MSN showing that Medicare has approved a \$0.00 amount for the claim. (This means that Medicare has or will recoup the payment.)
- 6. Report the possible fraud to the SMP of NJ. We will need to open a file and will ask for your personal Medicare information.
